Word count: 500-750 words

Rules: At Assured Intelligence, we find rules kind of boring. That said, we're not feral, so we do have a couple of guidelines.

- We don't share: We will never publish work that is published elsewhere. All editorial is exclusive to Assured Intelligence and we're too proud of our content to allow anyone else to share our glory. So if the op-ed is pitched or published elsewhere, please save us (and yourselves) the effort of running it through plagiarism software and getting rejected.
- We're not marketeers: We don't do product reviews or endorsements and won't publish articles that do either. So promote your ideas, creativity and brilliance, but not your product.
- We don't discriminate: We are passionate about the power of diversity of thought, and we actively seek diverse authors with wonderfully diverse opinions.

Process: Please send a pitch proposal to Eleanor@assured.co.uk. Include the topic you'd like to write about and a brief (less than 75 words) synopsis of the proposed topic. Please also include the author's name and job title. Eleanor will let you know if your proposal is accepted and give a commission with a deadline if so.
